Special Dialogue: Human Rights, Participation and Extreme Poverty 3:30 pm to 4:30 pm – Conference Room 8

END OF THE PUBLIC CEREMONY

This special meeting will be an opportunity for a **dialogue** between **ATD Fourth World delegates** with a direct experience of poverty, **Ambassadors** (Permanent Representatives of France and Burkina Faso to the UN) and **UN officials** (President of ECOSOC, UN agencies representatives). This dialogue will be facilitated by **Mr. Craig Mokhiber**, Director, New York Office, OHCHR.

Suggested program:

- 3.30pm Introduction by Mr. Craig Mokhiber:
 - Context 70th anniversary of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights.
 - How is the UN and its agencies taking into account the voices and direct experiences of people living in poverty? What are the obstacles to participation? What has worked?
- 3.35pm **Opening remarks by the delegation of the Fourth World Movement** to share about their life experience in relation to poverty and discrimination, and how they have been involved in participatory processes at local or international levels.
- 3.55pm Reactions of the UN officials
- 4.10pm **Dialogue between all participants**.

Questions to guide the discussion:

- What can UN agencies (UN DESA, UNDP, OHCHR, UNICEF) concretely do to ensure and improve participation in their policies and in their projects at country level and global level?
- How can the ECOSOC recommend stronger participation in the different functional commissions, regional commissions and High Level Political Forum? How to create the cultural shift?
