Dr. Anirudh Krishna

Professor Krishna will present findings on movements in and out of poverty in four developing countries (India, Kenya, Peru and Uganda) and will consider the poverty-inducing impact of Covid-19 in these countries. He will also discuss factors that strengthen household resilience, including the promotion of human development and investment in career ladders.









Dr. Anirudh Krishna

Professor Krishna is the Edgar T. Thompson Professor of Public Policy and Political Science at Duke University. His research investigates how poor communities and individuals in developing countries cope with the structural and personal constraints that result in poverty and powerlessness. His most recent book, The Broken Staircase: The Paradox and the Potential of India's One-Billion, won the A. K. Coomaraswamy book award of the Association for Asian Studies.
